## Fabric Requirements

- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards Fun-C5741 Ocean
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yard Fun-C5742 Pink
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards Studio-C3096 Leaf (includes binding)
- $\frac{2}{3}$  yard Fun-C5744 Green
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yard Fun-C5745 Blue
- $\frac{5}{8}$  yard Venice-C5600 Turquoise
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard Fun-C5744 Fuchsia
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards Studio-C3096 Cloud
- 4 yards Oasis backing fabric of your choice

## Cutting

### From Fun-C5741 Ocean:

- Cut seven 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips for outer border.
- Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut nine 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From Fun-C5742 Pink:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut seventy-two 2" squares.

### From Studio-C3096 Leaf:

- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-six 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- Cut two 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
- Cut six 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for inner border.
- Cut seven 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

### From Fun-C5744 Green:

- Cut one 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.
- Cut four 9 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

### From Fun-C5745 Blue:

- Cut two 9 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

### From Venice-C5600 Turquoise:

- Cut two 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut eighteen 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Cut six 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for middle border.

### From Fun-C5744 Fuchsia:

- Cut one 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut twelve 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From Studio-C3096 Cloud:

- Cut two 9 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut six 9 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut thirty-six 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

- Cut two 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut eighteen 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- Cut one 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.

## Block Construction

All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Draw a diagonal from corner to corner on each 2" C5742 Pink square (*figure 1*).
2. Place one marked square on the 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " C3096 Cloud rectangle as shown, noting the line direction, and sew along the marked line (*figure 2*).
3. Cut off the lower triangle section, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press open the triangle (*figure 3*).
4. Repeat for the opposite side of the C3096 Cloud rectangle to complete the flying-geese unit (*figure 4*). Repeat to make a total of thirty-six flying geese units.

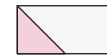

**Flying Geese Unit**  
Make 36.

5. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " C3096 Cloud square. Place the marked square over a 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " C5600 Turquoise square and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the marked line (*figure 5*).
6. Cut along the drawn line and press the triangles open to form half-square triangle (HST) units (*figure 6*). Press the seams toward the Turquoise fabric. Make a total of thirty-six units.
7. Sew a 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " C3096 Leaf rectangle below a flying-geese unit as shown (*figure 7*). Press seams toward the Leaf fabric. Make a total of thirty-six units.

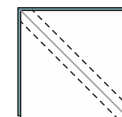

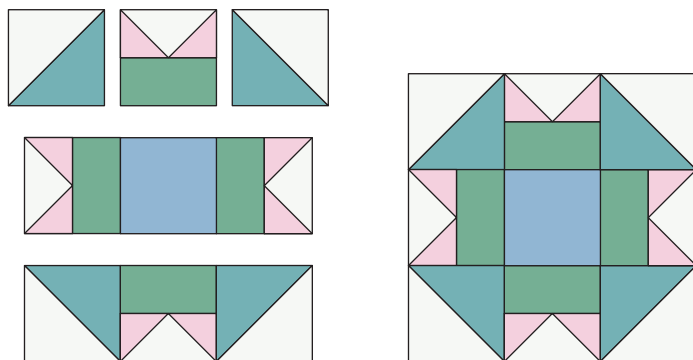

8. Using four Turquoise/Cloud HST, four flying geese units, and one  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " C5741 Ocean square, lay out the pieces in three rows as shown, noting the orientation (*figure 8*). Sew the pieces together in each row and press seams for adjacent rows in alternate directions. Make a total of nine Flower Blocks.

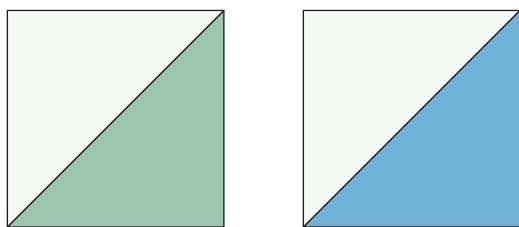

**Flower Block**

9. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using four  $9\frac{7}{8}$ " C3096 Cloud and four  $9\frac{7}{8}$ " C5744 Green squares to make a total of eight HST. Press the seams on four toward the Green and four toward the Cloud fabric.

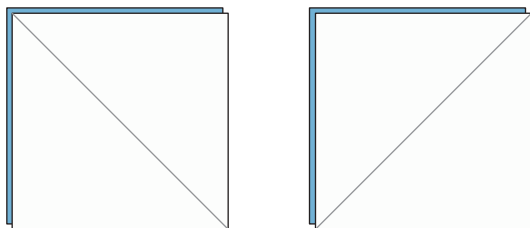

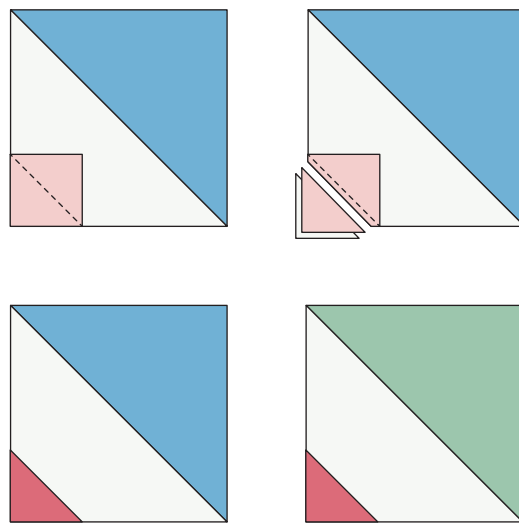
10. Using the remaining two  $9\frac{7}{8}$ " C3096 Cloud and C5745 Blue squares, make four HST (*figure 9*). Press seams towards the Blue. When placing the Cloud square on the Blue square, place the drawn line from top left to bottom right on one unit and from bottom left to top right on the second unit so the flamingos will be standing up on the quilt (*figure 10*).

11. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " C5744 Fuchsia square and place it on the Cloud corner of the HST. Sew along the line, trim the seam allowances to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and open the triangle, pressing the seam toward the Cloud fabric (*figure 11*).

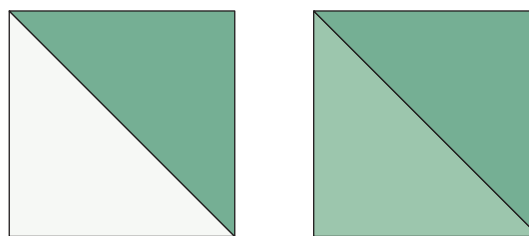


**Modified HST Block**

12. Following step 11, add a C5744 Fuchsia corner to each of the remaining HST. Make a total of twelve Modified HST Blocks—four Blue and eight Green.
13. Using the two  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " C3096 Leaf squares, one  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " C3096 Cloud square and one  $10\frac{1}{4}$ " C5744 Green square, make four HST—two of each color combination shown (*figure 12*).

14. With the Leaf fabrics opposite each other, place a Green/Cloud unit on a Green/Leaf unit, right sides facing and diagonal seams matching (*figure 13*).

Draw a diagonal line perpendicular to the seam and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line (*figure 14*).

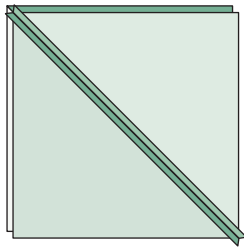
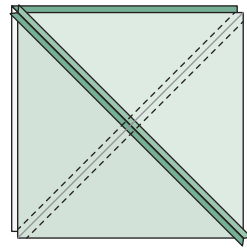
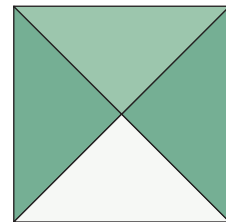

15. Cut along the drawn line and separate the pieces. Press open the resulting pieced triangles to make four quarter-square triangle units (QST) (*figure 15*). Trim to  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square if needed.

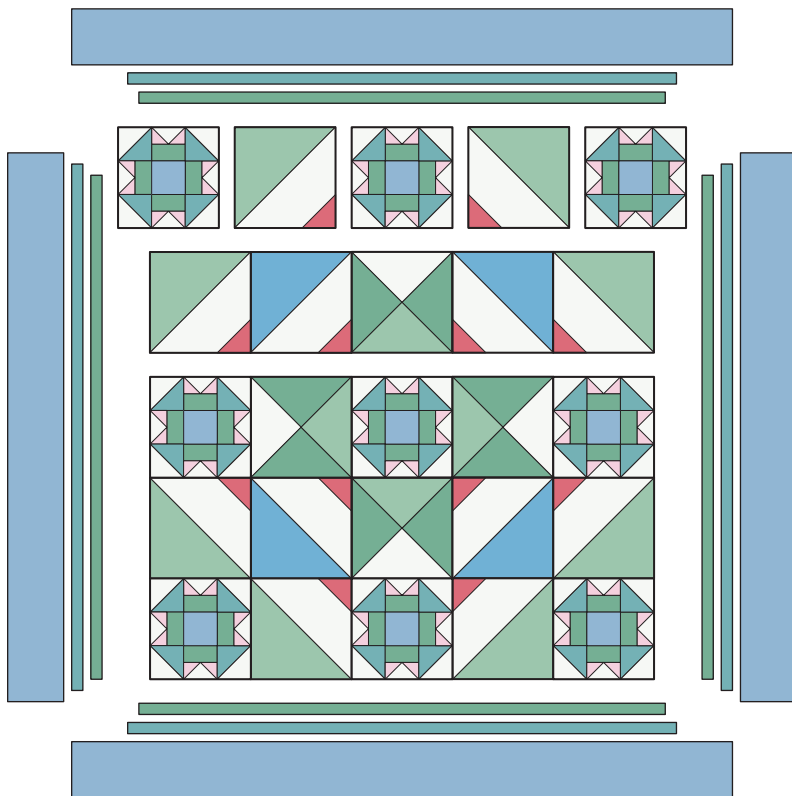

### Quilt Top Assembly

16. Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out the blocks as shown, noting the orientation. Position the Modified HST Blocks with the seams pressed toward the Cloud fabric in the top and bottom rows.

17. Sew the blocks together within each row, pressing the seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows.
18. Sew the rows together in order, matching adjacent seams.
19. Sew together three  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C5600 Turquoise strips end to end using diagonal seams. Cut in two equal lengths. Repeat with the remaining Turquoise strips, and the six  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C3096 Leaf strips.
20. Sew together three  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C5741 Ocean strips end to end using diagonal seams. Cut into two equal lengths. Sew together two  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C5741 Ocean strips for each side.
21. Sew on the side Leaf borders and trim the excess length. Repeat for the top and bottom inner borders.
22. Repeat step 21 using the Turquoise middle border strips, then the Ocean outer borders, noting the orientation of the flamingos.

### Finishing

23. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
24. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
25. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

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
