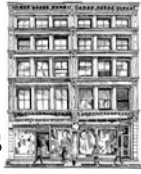

## Fabric Requirements

1/2 yard Tonga-B2805 Butter  
3/4 yard Tonga-B6198 Believe (includes 1/2 yard for binding)  
1/4 yard Tonga-B5305 Pink  
1/2 yard Tonga-B5942 Pacific  
1/4 yard Tonga-B4166 Apricot  
1/3 yard Tonga-B5269 Island  
1/4 yard Tonga-B5313 Duckling  
1/3 yard Tonga-B6203 Sparkle  
1/4 yard Tonga-B2968 Lilac  
1/3 yard Tonga-B4382 Sky  
1/4 yard Tonga-B6355 Fiji  
1/4 yard Tonga-B4382 Flamingo  
1/2 yard Tonga-B6367 Orchid  
1/2 yard Tonga-B5313 Breeze  
1/3 yard Tonga-B6192 Unicorn  
1/3 yard Tonga-B5041 Dream  
1/2 yard Tonga-B6300 Murmur  
1/3 yard Tonga-B5403 Lemon  
1 yard Tonga-B6219 Pastel  
1/2 yard Tonga-B4860 Magic  
3 3/4 yards Tonga-B4860 Magic (backing)

### Other Supplies

65" x 77" batting  
2 yards 12"-wide paper-back fusible web

## Cutting

*From each of Tonga-B2805 Butter (A), Tonga-B5942 Pacific (D) and Tonga-B6300 Murmur (Q):*

- Cut two 3" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut fifteen 3" squares.
- Cut one 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 3" strips.
- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 4 1/2" strips.

*From Tonga-B6198 Believe (B):*

- Cut one 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 3" strips.
- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 4 1/2" strips.
- Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

*From Tonga-B5305 Pink (C):*

- Cut two 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifteen 3" squares.

*From each of Tonga-B4166 Apricot (E), Tonga-B2968 Lilac (I) and Tonga-B4382 Flamingo (L):*

- See instructions to cut fifteen circles.

*From each of Tonga-B5269 Island (F) and Tonga-B4382 Sky (J):*

- Cut two 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifteen 4 1/2" squares.

*From each of Tonga-B5313 Duckling (G) and Tonga-B6355 Fiji (K):*

- Cut two 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifteen 3" squares.

*From each of Tonga-B6203 Sparkle (H), Tonga-B6192 Unicorn (O), Tonga-B5041 Dream (P) and Tonga-B5403 Lemon (R):*

- Cut one 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 3" strips.
- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut thirty 1 1/4" x 4 1/2" strips.

*From each of Tonga-B6367 Orchid (M) and Tonga-B5313 Breeze (N):*

- Cut two 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifteen 4 1/2" squares.
- Cut two 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut fifteen 3" squares.

*From Tonga-B6219 Pastel (S):*

- Cut four 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- Cut three 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- See instructions to cut fifteen circles.

*From Tonga-B4860 Magic (T):*

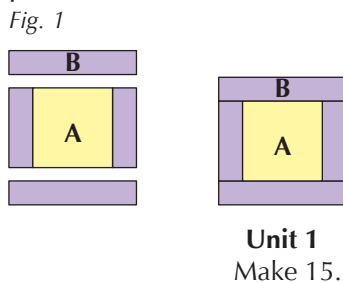
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 66 1/2" strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 57 1/2" strips.



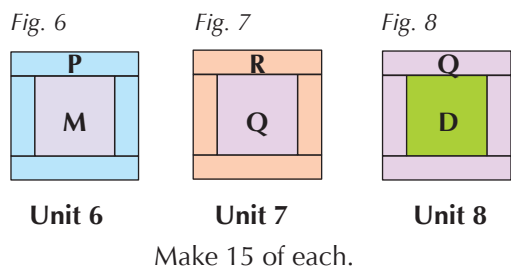
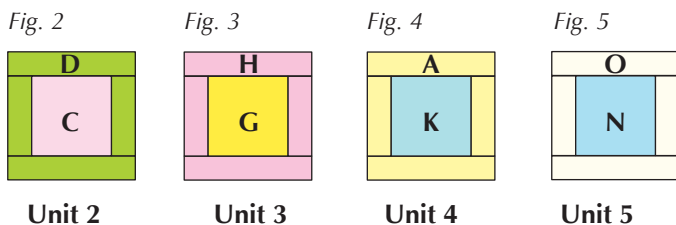
## Block Construction

All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

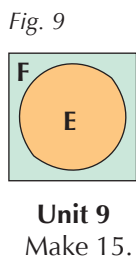
- Sew one  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3" B6198 Believe strip to each side of one 3" B2805 Butter square. Sew one  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " B6198 Believe strip to the top and another to the bottom of the B2805 Butter square to make one Unit 1 block (figure 1). Repeat to make a total of fifteen Unit 1.



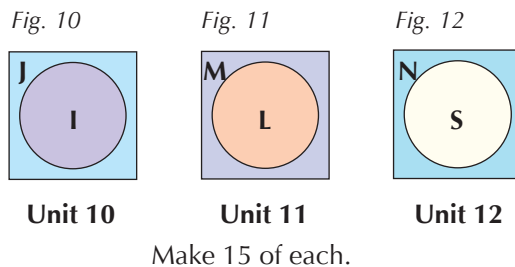
- Repeat Step 1 and use Figures 2-8 for fabric identification and location to make fifteen of each block, Unit 2 through Unit 8.



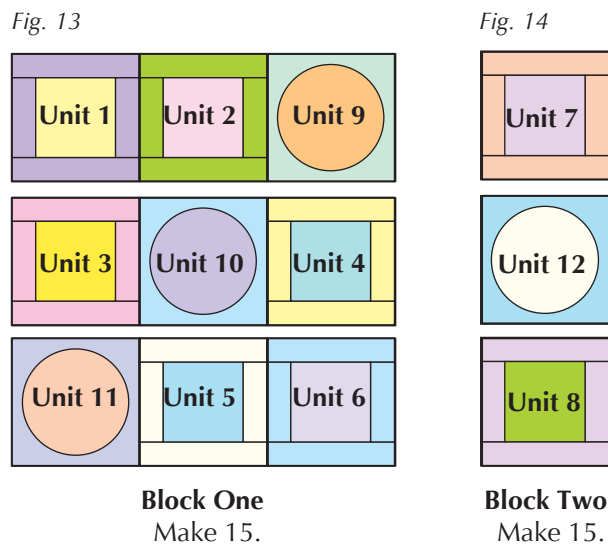
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each circle template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough-cut each template about  $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn lines.
- Press each fusible web circle onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the template. Cut out each circle on the drawn lines.
- Refer to Figure 9 to arrange and press one B4166 Apricot circle onto one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " B5269 Island square.



- Finish the raw edge with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole, blanket or satin stitch to make one Unit 9 block.
- Repeat Steps 5-6 to make a total of fifteen Unit 9.
- Repeat Steps 5-6 and use Figures 10-12 for fabric identification and location to make fifteen each of Unit 10, Unit 11 and Unit 12.

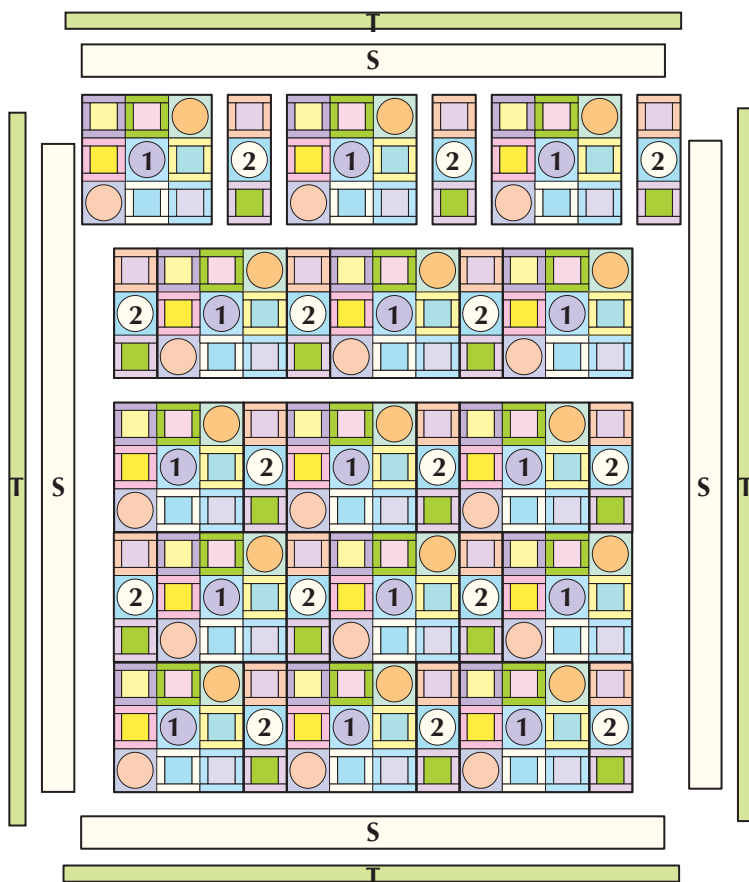


- Sew one Unit 1, one Unit 2 and one Unit 9 together in that order to make the top row.
- Sew one Unit 3, one Unit 10 and one Unit 4 together in that order to make the middle row.
- Sew one Unit 11, one Unit 5 and one Unit 6 together in that order to make the bottom row.
- Sew the three rows from Steps 9-11 together in order to make one Block One (figure 13). Repeat to make a total of fifteen Block One.
- Sew one Unit 7 to the top of one Unit 12. Sew one Unit 8 to the bottom of the Unit 12 to make one Block Two (figure 14). Repeat to make a total of fifteen Block Two.



## Quilt Top Assembly

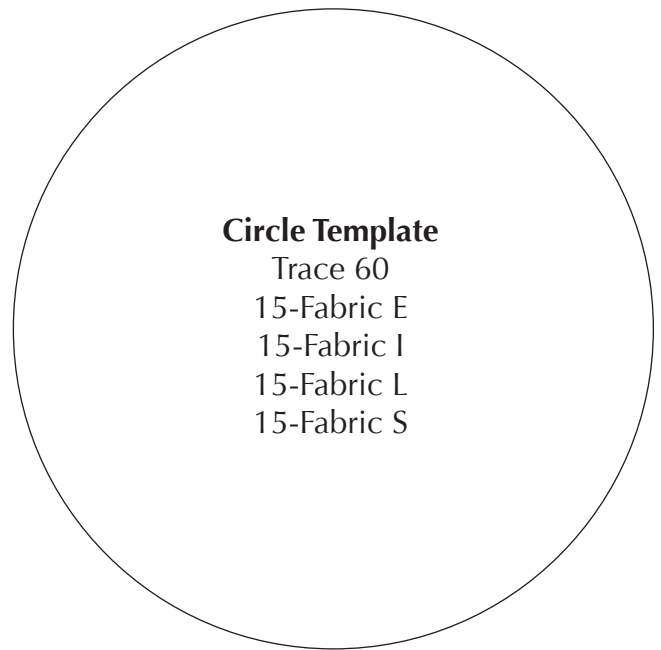
- Alternately sew three Block One and three Block Two together to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.
- Alternately sew three Block Two and three Block One together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- Sew the five rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
- Sew one 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" B6219 Pastel strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" B6219 Pastel strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the Center Block.
- Sew one 2" x 66 1/2" B4860 Magic strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 57 1/2" B4860 Magic strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing

- Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
- Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
